Residential Waste/Recycling Service Delayed by One Day for Independence Day

SAN DIEGO, CA – Waste Management of San Diego’s curbside residential trash and recycling pick-up schedule will be delayed by one day and will not operate on Monday, July 5, in observance of Independence Day.

Residential customers who receive Monday service in the following cities, should place their bins out for pick-up on Tuesday, July 6:

- El Cajon
- Santee
- Communities in unincorporated San Diego County, including 4S Ranch, Lakeside, Spring Valley, Alpine and Jamul

“Residential customers who usually receive service on Monday will instead receive it Tuesday, and so on throughout the week, with Friday’s customers receiving service on Saturday,” said Carl Scherbaum, district manager. “We appreciate our customers’ cooperation with the holiday schedule so that our employees can observe Independence Day.”

Business commercial trash and recycling services in these cities and the City of San Diego will be unaffected by the holiday – these services will remain on the regular Monday through Saturday schedule for the same week.

The local Waste Management office will be closed on Monday, July 5. The buyback center and the customer service center will be closed on Saturday, July 3 with normal operations resuming on Tuesday, July 6.
