Residential Waste/Recycling Service Delayed by One Day in Observance of Labor Day

(SAN DIEGO) – [Waste Management of San Diego's](#) curbside residential trash and recycling pick-up schedule will be delayed by one day and will not operate on Monday, September 6, in observance of Labor Day.

Residential customers who receive Monday service in the following cities, should place their bins out for pick-up on Tuesday, September 7:

- El Cajon
- Santee
- Communities in unincorporated San Diego County, including 4S Ranch, Lakeside, Spring Valley, Alpine and Jamul

Commercial service will be on regular schedule and there will be no delay. Commercial trash and recycling services will not be affected by the holiday – these services will remain on the regular Monday through Saturday schedule for the same week.

“Residential customers who usually receive service on Monday will instead receive it Tuesday, and so on throughout the week, with Friday’s customers receiving service on Saturday,” said Carl Scherbaum, district manager. “We appreciate our residential customers’ cooperation with the holiday schedule so that all of our employees can observe Labor Day.”

The local Waste Management offices will be closed on Monday, September 6th.
